Parent Tips

- View with a purpose: Be deliberate when inviting your child to watch a PBS KIDS show. These cards can help by adding meaningful conversation and easy activities to their experience.
- **Together is better:** Cards are designed for both individual or group work, with a grownup guiding the conversation.



Let's Talk!

What did Elinor and her friends wonder about? What questions did they ask?

Let's Do!

What do you wonder about?
Grab your science notebook and go outside to observe. Write down your questions about what you wonder.

Let's Talk!

Elinor and her friends are curious together. Share how Elinor, Olive, and Ari observe in their own special ways.

Let's Do!

Think of your family and friends. How do they help you be curious and explore safely? Invite them to plan a nature walk to observe plants or animals.

Let's Talk!

What character are you most like? What animal would you want to be if you lived in Animal Town?

Let's Do!

Draw a picture of you with Elinor,
Olive and Ari. What adventure
might you have?

Let's Talk!

What tools did Elinor and her friends use to explore? How were the tools helpful?

Let's Do!

Make observation binoculars by taping two empty paper rolls together. Attach a string to make them easier to carry. Use them to observe your surroundings.

Let's Talk!

Elinor often uses music to explain what she learns. What was the song about? What did it teach you?

Let's Do!

Make up your own song about something you know! You could sing about nature, friends, or school.

Let's Talk!

Elinor's mom, Ranger Rabbit, is a park ranger for Animal Town. What things does she do for her job? What job do you want when you grow up?

Let's Do!

Pretend you are a park ranger for Animal Town or your neighborhood. Use your imagination as you observe, teach, and even offer a tour to your friends!
