



FOLDING GLOBE: NORTHERN HEMISPHERE

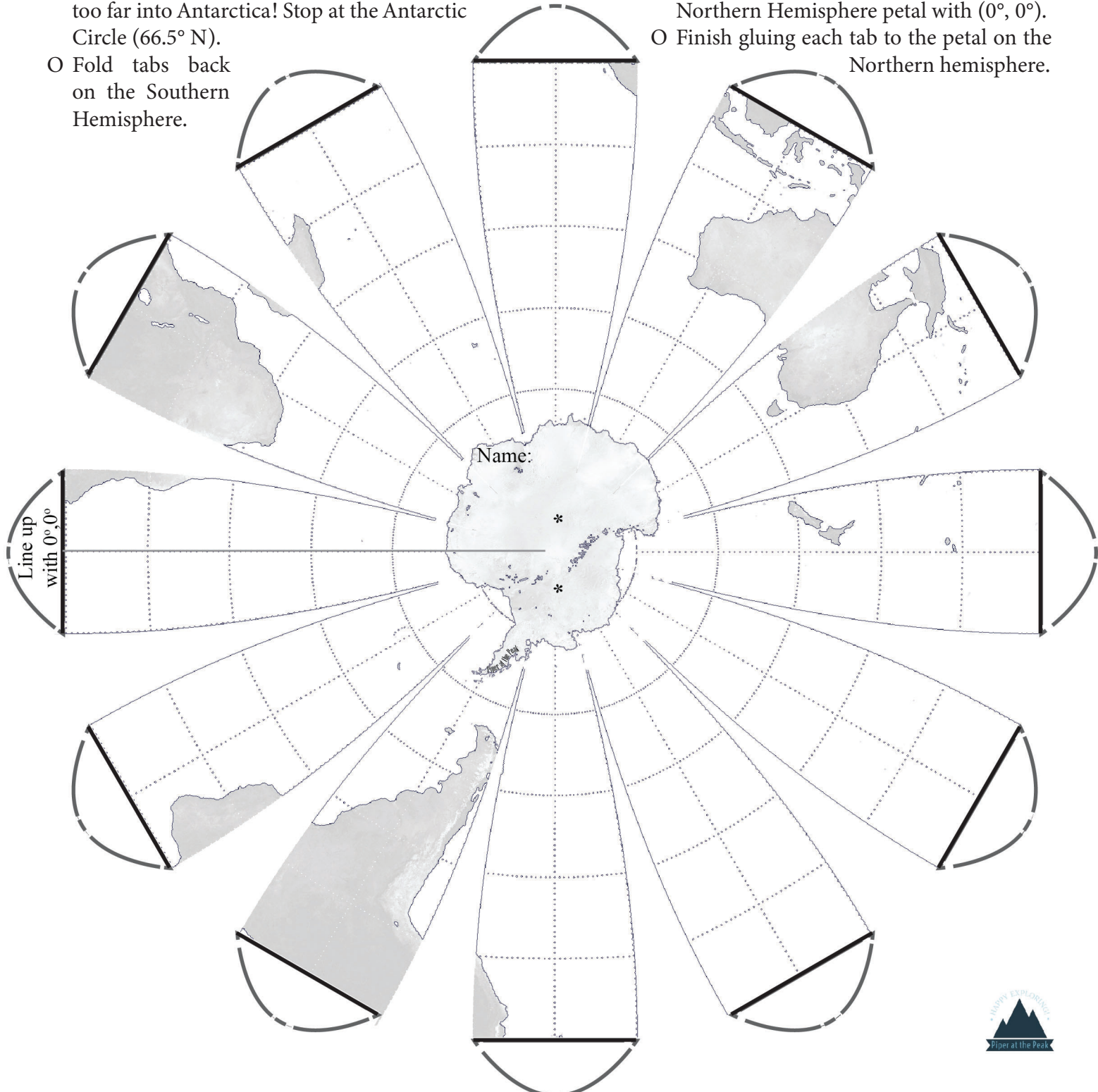
- Cut exactly on the SOLID line for the Equator on this hemisphere. As you cut around the petals, be careful not to cut too far into the Arctic. Don't cut beyond the Arctic Circle at 66.5° N.
- Poke two holes near each pole using the * * as guides.
- Thread a 10" string through the holes in the Northern Hemisphere and tie a loop to create Earth's axis.
- Repeat for the Southern Hemisphere.





FOLDING GLOBE: SOUTHERN HEMISPHERE

- Write your name on Antarctica.
- As you cut, leave TABS on each petal. Do not cut too far into Antarctica! Stop at the Antarctic Circle (66.5° N).
- Fold tabs back on the Southern Hemisphere.
- Check to make sure thread handles are tied.
- Line up the tab with (0° , 0°) and glue to the Northern Hemisphere petal with (0° , 0°).
- Finish gluing each tab to the petal on the Northern hemisphere.
