Jackie Joyner-Kersey's Favorite Sport




Make a trombone from recyclable materials. Practice playing like jazz musician, Trombone Shorty.



Misty Copeland




Mae C. Jemison is the first Black woman to enter the NASA space program. Make a rocket.

Celebrating Black Leaders

The month of February honors the important role Black people play in the story of our country. Across the United States, schools and communities organize to learn more about Black History and Culture. Match the historical Black figure with the description that shares a piece of what they accomplished.



Zora Neale Hurston

He was a lawyer, judge and civil rights activist. In 1967, he became the first Black person appointed to the U.S Supreme Court



Jackie Robinson

He studied plants and worked to improve the lives of Black farmers in the South. He created 105 recipes using peanuts!



Celia Cruz

She escaped slavery and returned several times to lead other slaves to freedom on the Underground Railroad throughout the 1850s.

In 1947, he became the first Black baseball player to play in the American major leagues during the 20th century. He played with the Brooklyn Dodgers.

Thurgood Marshall



She was known as the "Queen of Salsa" and is famous for helping popularize Afro-Cuban and Latin music all over the world. She recorded more than 70 albums!

Harriet Tubman



She was a poet and wrote plays and books. She was one of the few Black women who were published during her lifetime.



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


